Computer Physicians, LLC is not responsible for loss of profit or any direct, indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damage occurring during or after computer service. I also release Computer Physicians, LLC from liability associated with any hardware, diskettes, or other media sent in connection with this waiver.

ALL CLAIMS FOR LIABILITY AND/OR LOSS INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHICH MAY OCCUR AS A RESULT OF ANY COMPUTER PHYSICIANS, LLC ACTION (OR INACTION) ARE HEREBY EXPRESSLY WAIVED.

<u>Payment:</u> Work will be billed \$99 per hour plus a travel fee for onsite work, remote work or for work dropped off and picked up at the workshop. Charges may be more for emergency/fast work/holiday. All parts, supplies, taxes are extra charges. I understand that payment is due in full at the time of service and unless specified in writing on the work order, and that charges are binding whether service is successful or not. If the customer is unsatisfied with any of the repairs or service, the customer must notify the technician before he/she leaves the premises. The client acknowledges that there is a \$40.00 fee for any returned checks. If Computer Physicians, LLC is asked to perform repair work on-site that there will be a separate travel fee charge. If there is monitoring or repair of the system via remote access there will be a hourly fee charge. Please request fee schedule.

Estimated Completion Time: Computer Physicians, LLC will provide an estimated completion time for your repair/install. Please call before you come in to pick up your equipment or to schedule a drop off. Unforeseen circumstances may have an impact on our ability to complete the repair(s) as provided in the estimate. I understand that most repairs take from between 1 to 5 days, sometimes longer. Longer if parts/software must be ordered, and or system was dropped and/or spillage occurred to computer prior to client bringing system to Computer Physicians, LLC. I agree that Computer Physicians, LLC will be held free and harmless for computers picked up or requested to be dropped off before completion by Computer Physicians, LLC due to clients need for computer returned before completion of repair.

<u>Hardware Replacement:</u> Any old parts/hardware will be returned to you when you pick up your computer. I understand that repair replacement parts may be new, used, and/or refurbished depending on the situation. <u>Impact of Upgrades:</u> Please be advised that it is your responsibility to understand the impact of upgrades to the operating system, applications and utility software. Such upgrades can lead to incompatibilities and the possible loss of data. Computer hardware and software work together and incompatibility may not become apparent until a later date. You are responsible for contacting the manufacturer of your software and or hardware regarding compatibility issues before you request any upgrades.
